Activities with the local community and discussion on environmental issues subjected to analysis "Landscape, Traditions and Biodiversity" in order to frame with the local Working Group the issues on which to focus memories, animations, and perspectives (narration, theatre, acting, etc.). The community and the working groups investigated starting from the associations, from the informal groups(senior center bowling alley, etc.) what and how to tell about one's own experience with repercussions on the present and on the proposals for policymakers. Artists in residence, actors, videomakers, photographers, and artists were invited, with whom to interpret the wills and channel the stimuli. A three-day program of community workshops was organized and the experts and artists involved will dialogue with the residents engaging them.

The Municipality of Tripolis organized a three-day film workshop entitled "Filming of oral narratives by people of the Arcadian countryside", within the framework of the European program "PRO.GRE.S.S."

Through this three-day workshop, young people and residents of Tripoli were trained in the way of filming oral testimonies and were thus able to adequately record what will be told on camera by inhabitants of the Arcadian countryside: testimonies that touch on issues of conservation and preservation of the natural heritage, enhancement of natural and cultural assets, preservation of biodiversity, the ecological function of forest areas and enhancement of the connection function of landscapes.

The participants developed new skills and learned methodological tools useful in their research, educational, or even artistic activities, they "saw" and "heard" in new ways the stories of rural people, and thus the degree of participation increased in the European debate on the environment and climate change. At the same time, they learned new practices, which they will be able to implement in their own professional and social areas of action in the future.

It is an exciting journey into the field of oral history, an opening to the world of Human-Centered Documentary, the most emerging genre of cinema, which gives voice to ordinary, everyday people. Through their own experiential narratives, films are made with truth, emotion, and humor, which move, entertain, and educate while at the same time exploring modern everyday life, tradition, nature, history, and economic life.


