Description  Provide a short description of the event and its activities.			

Consell de Mallorca organised the 1<sup>st</sup> international online conference "Discovering biodiversity at Sa Dragonera Natural Park" on the 8<sup>th</sup> of June 2023 (WP3, task 3.2). The conference was held as an online event with a duration of 70 minutes. 133 participants from the four countries involved in the project attended the Conference (Spain, France, Greece and Italy).

In order to facilitate the participation of local communities from all territories involved in the project, two types of measures were carried out to overcome language and ICT barriers. On the one hand, simultaneous interpretation was provided from Spanish into French, Greek and Italian. On the other hand, a meeting room was made available in the municipality of Andratx, where *Sa Dragonera* Natural Park (Spain) is located, and in the municipality of Farnese (Italy), thus anyone who needed could follow the conference from the meeting room. 32 people took advantage of these facilities.

Previous to the celebration of the international conference, activities and discussions were carried out with the local community to know about their concerns, opinions and needs regarding environmental issues related to "Landscape, Traditions and Biodiversity" (Task 3.1) and decide the next initiatives to be carried out in the framework of the project (animations, storytelling, new proposals...). These activities and discussions have also helped to focus on the contents of the first international conference.

The following tasks have been carried out with the local community:

On the 2<sup>nd</sup> of April 2023, under the slogan "**Participatory process in Sa Dragonera Natural Park**", a local community survey was conducted on the stand dedicated to Sa Dragonera Natural Park at the Andratx Fair 2023.

Questionnaires were designed for the survey. Respondents filled in the questionnaire using a QR code or on paper. The main aim of this activity was to obtain information about the citizens who will make up the future community of the Park. More than 100 people answered the guestionnaire.



On the 22nd of April, Consell de Mallorca, in collaboration with the *Grup d'Ornitologia Balear*, organised the workshop "**Do you want to know how to study birds?**". The main objective of this activity was to raise awareness about scientific bird ringing and its importance for the study and conservation of birds.



On the 27<sup>th</sup> May 2023, the **workshop "Discovering butterflies at Sa Dragonera Natural Park"** was organized with the aim to learn about butterfly monitoring in the park.



On the 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2023, Consell de Mallorca in collaboration with MedGardens and a master craftswoman organized a **workshop on palm braiding technique.** The aim of this workshop was to learn this traditional technique and to participate in the creation of vegetal anchoring structures for replanting *Posidonia oceanica*.



In addition to the workshops and the survey addressed to the local community, face-to-face and online meetings have been held with some local entities to introduce the project and encourage them to participate in the activities and initiatives arising from it.


The 1st international conference (8 June 2023) was designed on the basis of feedback received from organizations and citizens. The conference focused on the different studies and scientific monitoring carried out in the protected area of *Sa Dragonera* Natural Park (Mallorca). In particular, presentations focused on the importance of knowing the state of conservation and the threats or risk factors that may affect the proper conservation of species such as Balearic and Cinderella shearwaters, the Eleonora falcon, butterflies, the Balearic lizard, etc.

The conference began with a welcome and a brief introduction to the event and the project by the director of *Sa Dragonera* Natural Park. This was followed by several presentations on the different species present in the Park. They were given by three researchers from the Mediterranean Institute for Advanced Studies (IMEDEA) CSIC-UIB, an expert in Lepidoptera and an ornithologist. The presentations were as follows:

- The secret life of the Balearic lizard
- Great ocean voyagers: research on shearwaters at Sa Dragonera Natural Park
- Discovering butterflies and moths at Sa Dragonera Natural Park
- Eleonora's Falcon in Sa Dragonera. A summary of 20 years of population monitoring

The informative video "Balearic shearwater, now or never" by Biodiversity Foundation was also shown.

The floor was also given to a representative of *Xarxa Dragonera Blava*, an initiative carried out by Save the Med since 2019 to promote participatory governance in *Sa Dragonera* Marine Reserve.
